MORE THAN 1,600 DANCERS TO SHOWCASE TALENTS AT COUNTY DANCE FESTIVAL EVENTS

Dancers from all grade levels throughout the county will take part in the Anne Arundel County Public Schools Dance Festival, which is set to begin a six-show run on Thursday, February 4, 2010.

The festivals, which will feature a combined 1,623 dancers, are performance opportunities for elementary school through high school students to perform original dance pieces that have been choreographed by instructors at their schools, by students, or by guest choreographers. In 2009, all 12 high schools, nine middle schools, 35 elementary schools, and the Anne Arundel County Dance Ensemble performed in four sold-out concerts.

- February 19 at South River High School
