## Narrative

### BWC Capture

On 06/01/2019 at approximately 2240hours Ofc Ferracane and Off McQueen were dispatched to a call at 1162 Frederick Douglas Street for the complainant of a party that included loud music, illegal drug transactions, and alcohol violations. Off Baum and I were stationed in front of the 1155 building of Madison Street with APD's mobile command. A brief moment after Ofc Ferracane and Off McQueen arrived on scene at 1162 Frederick Douglas, Off McQueen asked for more units. As a result, I responded.

Upon arriving on scene I observed one subject detained and Ofc Ferracane and Off McQueen attempting to retrieve information from the subject in custody. I also observed a small crowd of approximately 15 subjects standing on the sidewalk yelling at the officers, and as a result, I stood between the officers and the crowd to ensure that the officers could continue their investigation.

While officers were conducting their investigation there was one subject, who was later identified as Mr. John Edwards Jr. (DOB:10/04/96), who was becoming more irate with the situation. I observed Mr. Edwards to yell obscenities towards myself and the other officers. Mr. Edwards, along with other subjects, began hindering and obstructing officers from their investigation. At this time, I advised Mr. Edwards to calm down and step away from the scene--Mr. Edwards refused, and became agitated stating, "I bet you I'll bail out" as he postured at officers. As Mr. Edwards was yelling obscenities at the officers, a larger crowd had formed. I observed several subjects exit their residence to see what the commotion was about. At this time I advised Mr. Edwards to turn around, place his hands behind his back, and that he was under arrest. Mr. Edwards slightly turned his back towards me and as I reached out with my right hand and grabbed his right hand (in an attempt to place him into handcuffs) Mr. Edwards abruptly turned around, breaking free from my grasp, and began swinging an unknown number of punches at me striking me about my upper body. As a result, Ofc Ferracane stepped in and attempted to assist in placing Mr. Edwards into handcuffs. Mr. Edwards continued to resist and Ofc Ferracane took Mr. Edwards to the ground where he continued to resist striking officers multiple times with his head and feet. This assault and resistance caused head injuries to Ofc Ferracane and bruising and swelling to my hands. Ofc Ferracane then was able to get to a position on top of Mr. Edwards and at this time Mr. Edwards. Ofc Ferracane advised Mr. Edwards to stop resisting and at this time, Mr. Edwards seized all resistance. Officers had items thrown at them while Mr. Edwards resisted to include trash, cups, and alcoholic beverages. While officers were attempting to place Mr. Edwards into custody, the crowd began to close in on officers. As the crowd closed in, Off McQueen deployed his Tazer to keep the crowd from further assaulting the officers. Eventually, Mr. Edwards was placed into custody.

After Mr. Edwards was placed into custody, a large crowd (at least 100 people) had formed. At this time several officers arrived on scene and attempted to conduct crowd control. After several minutes, the crowd was pushed back. As the result of the crowd AFD was advised to meet officers at APD to render aid to Mr. Edwards. Ofc Ferracane and I both sustained injuries as a result of Mr. Edwards resisting arrest. Mr. Edwards was transported to AAMC where he was treated for injures as a result of him resisting arrest. Ofc Ferracane and I were transported to AAMC and were treated for our injuries.

After Mr. Edwards was released from AAMC he was transported back to APD where he was booked, processed, and charged on statement of charges tracking number 170001104722 for the following charges:

- 2nd degree assault on a police officer (x2)
- Reckless Endangerment (x2)
- Resisting arrest (x2)
- Disorderly Conduct
- Fail to obey lawful order

Mr. Edwards was transported to the Commissioners' Office.
